- 1 AN ACT Relating to flood insurance coverage; and adding a new
- 2 section to chapter 48.27 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 48.27 RCW to read as follows:
- 6 (1) Every insurer issuing a homeowner, condominium unit owner, 7 residential tenant, and residential fire insurance policy must notify
- 8 the policyholder that the policy does not cover damage caused by flood. 9 The notice must also inform the policyholder how to contact the
- 10 national flood insurance program ("NFIP") or one of the NFIP's agents.
- 11 This notice must be provided:
- 12 (a) At the time the policy is issued; and
- 13 (b) At the time the policy is renewed.
- 14 (2) The following language, when combined with current information
- 15 about how to contact the NFIP or its agent, satisfies the notice
- 16 requirements of this section:
- 17 "This policy does not cover damage to your property caused by
- 18 flooding. The federal government offers flood insurance through the

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- 1 National Flood Insurance Program to residents of communities that
- 2 participate in its program. You can learn more about the National
- 3 Flood Insurance Program at www.floodsmart.gov or by calling (888) 379-
- 4 9531."
- 5 (3) Nothing in this section invalidates a flood exclusion, or any
- 6 other exclusion, in an insurance policy subject to this section.

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
