- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 48.27 RCW to read as follows: 5
- (1) Every insurer must provide written notice at policy issuance 6 7 annually thereafter to homeowner, condominium unit owner, residential tenant, and residential fire insurance policyholders that 8 9 clearly and conspicuously discloses that the policy does not cover 10 damage caused by flooding. The notice must also inform the policyholder how to contact the national flood insurance program

- ("NFIP"), or one of the NFIP's agents, or both. 12
- 13 (2) The following language satisfies the notice requirements of 14 this section:
- 15 "This policy does not cover damage to your property caused by
- 16 flooding. The federal government offers flood insurance through the
- 17 National Flood Insurance Program to residents of communities that

- 4 If the contact information for the NFIP or its agents changes after
