1            AN ACT Relating to internet voting for service voters and overseas  
2 voters; and adding a new section to chapter 29A.40 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 29A.40 RCW  
5 to read as follows:

6            (1) The secretary of state is authorized to establish a method that  
7 allows service voters and overseas voters to cast a ballot over the  
8 internet.

9            (2) In reviewing ways to implement this section, the secretary of  
10 state will consider computing hardware and software systems that:

11            (a) Ensure the integrity and secrecy of the ballot and  
12 authentication of the voter;

13            (b) Meet relevant and prevailing computer security standards;

14            (c) Use system components that are available for audit and  
15 certification; and

16            (d) Allow for optional phased implementation.

17            (3) The secretary of state may seek alternative public or nonprofit  
18 funding sources to implement this section.

1           (4) The method established by the secretary of state for allowing  
2 service and overseas voters to vote over the internet is exempt from  
3 chapter 29A.12 RCW.
