- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.10 RCW to read as follows:
  - (1) Within existing resources and beginning in the 2009-10 academic year, the public baccalaureate institutions of higher education shall annually administer the collegiate learning assessment to a sample of students attending at least half time. The sample of students shall include the following elements:
- 11 (a) A minimum of one hundred freshmen and one hundred seniors shall 12 be assessed; institutions may include additional students in the sample 13 at the institution's discretion.
- 14 (b) The freshmen shall be assessed in the fall quarter or semester 15 of their first year; the seniors shall be assessed in the spring 16 quarter or semester before their graduation during the same academic 17 year.
- 18 (c) The sample shall include students from various majors, students 19 who receive student financial aid, and those who did not receive aid.

1 (2) Services and activities fees, as defined in RCW 28B.15.041, 2 shall be waived or rebated for all students who participate in the 3 testing for the entire academic year in which they were tested.
