- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 36.100.160 and 1995 c 396 s 13 are each amended to read as follows:
- The board of directors of the public facilities district shall have authority to authorize the expenditure of funds for the public purposes
- 8 of preparing and distributing information to the general public and
- 9 promoting, advertising, improving, developing, operating, and
- 10 maintaining facilities of the district. Nothing contained in this
- 11 section may be construed to authorize preparation and distribution of
- 12 information to the general public for the purpose of influencing the
- 13 outcome of a district election. <u>For promotional activities, the</u>
- 14 <u>district board shall identify the proposed expenditure in its annual</u>
- 15 <u>budget and adopt written rules governing promotional hosting by</u>
- 16 employees, agents, and the board.
- 17 Sec. 2. RCW 35.57.060 and 1999 c 165 s 6 are each amended to read
- 18 as follows:

p. 1 HB 1692

The board of directors of the public facilities district shall have authority to authorize the expenditure of funds for the public purposes of preparing and distributing information to the general public and promoting, advertising, improving, developing, operating, and maintaining a regional center. Nothing contained in this section may be construed to authorize preparation and distribution of information to the general public for the purpose of influencing the outcome of a district election. For promotional activities, the district board shall identify the proposed expenditure in its annual budget and adopt written rules governing promotional hosting by employees, agents, and the board.
