AN ACT Relating to increasing the punishment for assault of a child in the first degree; amending RCW 9.94A.540 and 9.94A.703; reenacting and amending RCW 9.94A.515; creating new sections; and providing an effective date.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. This act may be known and cited as the Eryk 7 Woodruff public safety act of 2009.

8 **Sec. 2.** RCW 9.94A.540 and 2005 c 437 s 2 are each amended to read 9 as follows:

10 (1) Except to the extent provided in subsection (3) of this 11 section, the following minimum terms of total confinement are mandatory 12 and shall not be varied or modified under RCW 9.94A.535:

(a) An offender convicted of the crime of murder in the first
 degree shall be sentenced to a term of total confinement not less than
 twenty years.

16 (b) An offender convicted of the crime of assault in the first 17 degree or assault of a child in the first degree where the offender used force or means likely to result in death or intended to kill the victim shall be sentenced to a term of total confinement not less than ((five)) eight years.

4 (c) An offender convicted of the crime of rape in the first degree 5 shall be sentenced to a term of total confinement not less than five 6 years.

7 (d) An offender convicted of the crime of sexually violent predator
8 escape shall be sentenced to a minimum term of total confinement not
9 less than sixty months.

10 (2) During such minimum terms of total confinement, no offender subject to the provisions of this section is eligible for community 11 12 custody, earned release time, furlough, home detention, partial 13 confinement, work crew, work release, or any other form of early release authorized under RCW 9.94A.728, or any other form of authorized 14 leave of absence from the correctional facility while not in the direct 15 custody of a corrections officer. The provisions of this subsection 16 shall not apply: (a) In the case of an offender in need of emergency 17 medical treatment; (b) for the purpose of commitment to an inpatient 18 treatment facility in the case of an offender convicted of the crime of 19 rape in the first degree; or (c) for an extraordinary medical placement 20 21 when authorized under RCW 9.94A.728(4).

(3)(a) Subsection (1) of this section shall not be applied in sentencing of juveniles tried as adults pursuant to RCW 13.04.030(1)(e)(i).

(b) This subsection (3) applies only to crimes committed on or after July 24, 2005.

27 **Sec. 3.** RCW 9.94A.703 and 2008 c 231 s 9 are each amended to read 28 as follows:

When a court sentences a person to a term of community custody, the court shall impose conditions of community custody as provided in this section.

32 (1) Mandatory conditions. As part of any term of community 33 custody, the court shall:

34 (a) Require the offender to inform the department of court-ordered35 treatment upon request by the department;

36 (b) Require the offender to comply with any conditions imposed by 37 the department under RCW 9.94A.704;

(c) If the offender was sentenced under RCW ((9.94A.712)) 9.94A.507
for an offense listed in RCW ((9.94A.712)) 9.94A.507(1)(a), and the
victim of the offense was under eighteen years of age at the time of
the offense, prohibit the offender from residing in a community
protection zone;

(d) If the offender was sentenced under RCW 9A.36.120, prohibit the
 offender from serving in any paid or volunteer capacity where he or she
 has control or supervision of minors under the age of thirteen.

9 (2) Waivable conditions. Unless waived by the court, as part of 10 any term of community custody, the court shall order an offender to:

11 (a) Report to and be available for contact with the assigned 12 community corrections officer as directed;

13 (b) Work at department-approved education, employment, or community 14 restitution, or any combination thereof;

(c) Refrain from possessing or consuming controlled substancesexcept pursuant to lawfully issued prescriptions;

(d) Pay supervision fees as determined by the department; and

(e) Obtain prior approval of the department for the offender'sresidence location and living arrangements.

20 (3) Discretionary conditions. As part of any term of community
 21 custody, the court may order an offender to:

(a) Remain within, or outside of, a specified geographicalboundary;

(b) Refrain from direct or indirect contact with the victim of thecrime or a specified class of individuals;

(c) Participate in crime-related treatment or counseling services;

(d) Participate in rehabilitative programs or otherwise perform affirmative conduct reasonably related to the circumstances of the offense, the offender's risk of reoffending, or the safety of the community;

(e) Refrain from consuming alcohol; or

32

(f) Comply with any crime-related prohibitions.

33 (4) Special conditions.

(a) In sentencing an offender convicted of a crime of domestic
violence, as defined in RCW 10.99.020, if the offender has a minor
child, or if the victim of the offense for which the offender was
convicted has a minor child, the court may order the offender to

participate in a domestic violence perpetrator program approved under
 RCW 26.50.150.

(b)(i) In sentencing an offender convicted of an alcohol or drug-3 4 related traffic offense, the court shall require the offender to complete a diagnostic evaluation by an alcohol or drug dependency 5 6 agency approved by the department of social and health services or a qualified probation department, defined under RCW 46.61.516, that has 7 been approved by the department of social and health services. 8 If the 9 offense was pursuant to chapter 46.61 RCW, the report shall be forwarded to the department of licensing. If the offender is found to 10 11 have an alcohol or drug problem that requires treatment, the offender 12 shall complete treatment in a program approved by the department of 13 social and health services under chapter 70.96A RCW. If the offender is found not to have an alcohol or drug problem that requires 14 treatment, the offender shall complete a course in an information 15 school approved by the department of social and health services under 16 chapter 70.96A RCW. The offender shall pay all costs for any 17 evaluation, education, or treatment required by this section, unless 18 19 the offender is eligible for an existing program offered or approved by 20 the department of social and health services.

21 (ii) For purposes of this section, "alcohol or drug-related traffic 22 offense" means the following: Driving while under the influence as 23 defined by RCW 46.61.502, actual physical control while under the 24 influence as defined by RCW 46.61.504, vehicular homicide as defined by 46.61.520(1)(a), vehicular assault defined 25 RCW as by RCW 26 46.61.522(1)(b), homicide by watercraft as defined by RCW 79A.60.050, 27 or assault by watercraft as defined by RCW 79A.60.060.

(iii) This subsection (4)(b) does not require the department of social and health services to add new treatment or assessment facilities nor affect its use of existing programs and facilities authorized by law.

17 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 6. This act takes effect August 1, 2009.
