- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 50.04 RCW to read as follows:
- 8 The term "employment" shall not include services performed by an
- 9 interpreter or translator under a written contract with a language
- 10 service provider for a specific engagement when the interpreter or
- 11 translator performs no other duties for the language service provider
- 12 and is not regularly and continuously employed by the language service
- 13 provider.
- 14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 51.08 RCW
- 15 to read as follows:
- 16 A person is not a "worker" for the purposes of this title, with
- 17 respect to his or her activities performed as an interpreter or
- 18 translator under a written contract with a language service provider
