- 1 AN ACT Relating to providing a property tax exemption for first-
- 2 time home buyers; adding a new section to chapter 84.36 RCW; adding a
- 3 new section to chapter 84.55 RCW; and creating a new section.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 84.36 RCW to read as follows:
- 7 (1) A residence purchased by a first-time home buyer is exempt from 8 property taxes levied for any state purpose.
 - (2) For purposes of this section, the following definitions apply:
- 10 (a) "First-time home buyer" means an individual who has not owned 11 a residence within three years of the purchase.
- 12 (b) "Residence" has the same meaning as in RCW 84.36.383.
- 13 (3) The exemption provided for in this section may not affect the
- 14 transfer of the state property tax levy into the student achievement
- 15 fund in RCW 84.52.068.

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- 16 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 84.55 RCW
- 17 to read as follows:
- The levy for the state in any year must be reduced as necessary to

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- 1 prevent exemptions under section 1 of this act from resulting in a
- 2 higher tax rate than would have occurred in the absence of the
- 3 exemptions under section 1 of this act.
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** The exemption in section 1 of this act
- 5 applies only to taxes levied for collection in 2010 and 2011.

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
