AN ACT Relating to volunteer firefighter special license plates; amending RCW 46.16.725, 46.16.601, 46.16.745, and 46.16.316; reenacting and amending RCW 46.16.313; and adding new sections to chapter 46.16 RCW.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 46.16 RCW 7 to read as follows:

8 (1) In cooperation with the department, the Washington state 9 firefighter's association shall create and design, and the department 10 shall issue, a special license plate displaying the volunteer 11 firefighter emblem that may be used in lieu of regular or personalized 12 license plates for vehicles required to display one or two vehicle 13 license plates, excluding vehicles registered under chapter 46.87 RCW, 14 upon terms and conditions established by the department.

(2) The special license plate created under this section is exempt
from review by the special license plate review board and RCW 46.16.725
and 46.16.745, except as provided in this section.

Sec. 2. RCW 46.16.313 and 2005 c 426 s 3, 2005 c 225 s 3, 2005 c 224 s 3, 2005 c 220 s 3, 2005 c 216 s 3, 2005 c 177 s 3, 2005 c 85 s 3, 2005 c 71 s 3, 2005 c 53 s 3, 2005 c 48 s 3, 2005 c 44 s 3, and 2005 c 4 2 s 3 are each reenacted and amended to read as follows:

(1) The department may establish a fee of no more than forty 5 dollars for each type of special license plates issued under RCW 6 7 46.16.301(1) (a), (b), or (c), as existing before amendment by section 8 5, chapter 291, Laws of 1997, in an amount calculated to offset the cost of production of the special license plates and the administration 9 10 of this program. This fee is in addition to all other fees required to register and license the vehicle for which the plates have been 11 12 requested. All such additional special license plate fees collected by 13 the department shall be deposited in the state treasury and credited to 14 the motor vehicle fund.

(2) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon 15 application and registration of a motor vehicle, the holder of a 16 17 collegiate license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty dollars. 18 The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration and 19 collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be 20 21 remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper 22 identifying detailed report. The state treasurer shall credit the funds to the appropriate collegiate license plate fund as provided in 23 24 RCW 28B.10.890.

(3) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon 25 26 renewal of a motor vehicle registration, the holder of a collegiate 27 license plate shall pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under 28 29 this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by 30 The remaining proceeds shall be remitted to the custody of the it. state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. The state 31 32 treasurer shall credit the funds to the appropriate collegiate license plate fund as provided in RCW 28B.10.890. 33

34 (4) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon 35 application and registration of a motor vehicle, the holder of a 36 special baseball stadium license plate shall pay an initial fee of 37 forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed 38 twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for

administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining 1 2 proceeds, minus the cost of plate production, shall be distributed to a county for the purpose of paying the principal and interest payments 3 4 on bonds issued by the county to construct a baseball stadium, as defined 82.14.0485, including reasonably 5 in RCW necessary preconstruction costs, while the taxes are being collected under RCW 6 7 82.14.360. After this date, the state treasurer shall credit the funds 8 to the state general fund.

9 (5) In addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon 10 renewal of a motor vehicle registration, the holder of a special baseball stadium license plate shall pay a fee of thirty dollars. 11 The 12 department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee 13 collected under this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be distributed 14 to a county for the purpose of paying the principal and interest 15 payments on bonds issued by the county to construct a baseball stadium, 16 17 as defined in RCW 82.14.0485, including reasonably necessary preconstruction costs, while the taxes are being collected under RCW 18 19 82.14.360. After this date, the state treasurer shall credit the funds to the state general fund. 20

21 (6) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on 22 January 1, 2005, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid 23 upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder of a 24 professional firefighters and paramedics license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount 25 26 not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this 27 subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state 28 treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW 29 30 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until the department determines that the state has been 31 32 reimbursed for the cost of implementing the professional firefighters and paramedics license plates. Upon the determination by the 33 department that the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall 34 35 credit the proceeds to the Washington State Council of Firefighters 36 benevolent fund established under RCW 46.16.30902.

37 (7) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on January38 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon

renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a professional 1 2 firefighters and paramedics license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to 3 exceed two dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for 4 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining 5 proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a 6 7 proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until 8 9 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the cost of implementing the professional firefighters and paramedics 10 special license plate. Upon the determination by the department that 11 12 the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds 13 to the Washington State Council of Firefighters benevolent fund established under RCW 46.16.30902. 14

15 (8) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on November 1, 2004, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid 16 17 upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder of a "Helping Kids Speak" license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty 18 19 dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve 20 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration 21 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be 22 remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper 23 identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state 24 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the 25 26 cost of implementing the "Helping Kids Speak" special license plate. 27 Upon the determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the "Helping 28 Kids Speak" account established under RCW 46.16.30904. 29

30 (9) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on November 1, 2005, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon 31 32 renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a "Helping Kids Speak" license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty dollars. 33 The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each 34 35 fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection 36 expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be remitted to 37 the custody of the state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit 38

1 the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until the department 2 determines that the state has been reimbursed for the cost of 3 implementing the "Helping Kids Speak" special license plate. Upon the 4 determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the 5 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the "Helping Kids Speak" account 6 established under RCW 46.16.30904.

7 (10) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due on 8 January 1, 2005, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid 9 upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder of a "law enforcement memorial" license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty 10 11 The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars. 12 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration 13 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper 14 15 identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until 16 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the 17 18 cost of implementing the law enforcement memorial special license 19 Upon the determination by the department that the state has plate. 20 been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the law 21 enforcement memorial account established under RCW 46.16.30906.

22 (11) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on January 23 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon 24 renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a "law enforcement memorial" license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty 25 26 dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two 27 dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds shall 28 be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper 29 30 identifying detailed report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until 31 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the 32 cost of implementing the law enforcement memorial special license 33 Upon the determination by the department that the state has 34 plate. 35 been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the law 36 enforcement memorial account established under RCW 46.16.30906.

37 (12)(a) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due38 on or after January 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required

to be paid upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder 1 2 of a Washington's Wildlife collection license plate shall pay an initial fee of forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount 3 4 not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. 5 The remaining proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state 6 7 treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW 8 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor 9 vehicle account until the department determines that the state has been 10 reimbursed for the cost of implementing the Washington's Wildlife license plate collection. Upon determination by the department that 11 12 the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds 13 to the state wildlife account. Proceeds credited to the state wildlife account from the sale of the Washington's Wildlife license plate 14 15 collection may be used only for the department of fish and wildlife's game species management activities. 16

(b) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on or after 17 January 1, 2007, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid 18 19 upon renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a Washington's Wildlife collection license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of 20 21 thirty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed 22 two dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for 23 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a 24 25 proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state 26 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until 27 the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the 28 cost of implementing the Washington's Wildlife license plate 29 collection. Upon determination by the department that the state has 30 been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the state wildlife account. Proceeds credited to the state wildlife account from 31 32 the sale of the Washington's Wildlife license plate collection may be used only for the department of fish and wildlife's game species 33 management activities. 34

35 (13)(a) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due 36 on or after January 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required 37 to be paid upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder 38 of a Washington state parks and recreation commission special license

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plate shall pay an initial fee of forty dollars. The department shall 1 2 deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection expenses 3 incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be remitted to the custody 4 of the state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. 5 Under RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to 6 7 the motor vehicle account until the department determines that the 8 state has been reimbursed for the cost of implementing the Washington 9 state parks and recreation commission special license plate. Upon 10 determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the state parks education and 11 12 enhancement account established in RCW 79A.05.059.

13 (b) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on or after January 1, 2007, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid 14 upon renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a Washington 15 state parks and recreation commission special license plate shall, upon 16 application, pay a fee of thirty dollars. The department shall deduct 17 an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under this 18 19 subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it. 20 The remaining proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state 21 treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW 22 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor 23 vehicle account until the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the cost of implementing the Washington state parks and 24 25 recreation commission special license plate. Upon determination by the 26 department that the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall 27 credit the proceeds to the state parks education and enhancement account established in RCW 79A.05.059. 28

29 (14)(a) Effective with vehicle registrations due or to become due 30 on or after January 1, 2006, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid upon application and registration of a vehicle, the holder 31 32 of a "Washington Lighthouses" license plate shall pay an initial fee of 33 forty dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for 34 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining 35 36 proceeds must be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a 37 proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until 38

the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the cost of implementing the "Washington Lighthouses" license plate. Upon determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the lighthouse environmental programs account established under RCW 46.16.30912.

б (b) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on or after 7 January 1, 2007, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid 8 upon renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of a "Washington 9 Lighthouses" license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty 10 dollars. The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for administration 11 12 and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining proceeds must be 13 remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer 14 shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until the 15 department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the cost 16 of implementing the "Washington Lighthouses" license plate. 17 Upon 18 determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the 19 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the lighthouse environmental programs account established under RCW 46.16.30912. 20

The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed 25 26 twelve dollars of each fee collected under this subsection for 27 administration and collection expenses incurred by it. The remaining 28 proceeds shall be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with 29 a proper identifying report. Pursuant to RCW 46.16.755, the state 30 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the 31 32 cost of implementing the "Keep Kids Safe" license plate. Upon determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the 33 treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the children's trust fund 34 35 established under RCW 43.121.100.

The remaining proceeds must be 38 remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper

identifying report. Under RCW 46.16.755, the state treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the motor vehicle account until the department determines that the state has been reimbursed for the cost of implementing the armed forces special license plate collection. Upon determination by the department that the state has been reimbursed, the treasurer shall credit the proceeds to the veterans stewardship account established under RCW 43.60A.140.

(b) Effective with annual renewals due or to become due on or after 8 9 January 1, 2007, in addition to all fees and taxes required to be paid 10 upon renewal of a vehicle registration, the holder of an armed forces license plate shall, upon application, pay a fee of thirty dollars. 11 12 The department shall deduct an amount not to exceed two dollars of each 13 fee collected under this subsection for administration and collection expenses incurred by it.
