- 1 AN ACT Relating to the organization of the department of social and
- 2 health services; amending RCW 43.20A.090 and 71.24.360; and adding a
- 3 new section to chapter 43.20A RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.20A RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (1) The department shall organize the regional service delivery 8 system around three geographic regions.
- 9 (a) Region I shall include the following counties: Okanogan,
- 10 Chelan, Douglas, Kittitas, Yakima, Benton, Grant, Ferry, Lincoln,
- 11 Adams, Franklin, Stevens, Pend Orielle, Spokane, Whitman, Walla Walla,
- 12 Columbia, Garfield, and Asotin.
- 13 (b) Region II shall include the following counties: Klickitat,
- 14 Skamania, Clark, Cowlitz, Wahkiakum, Pacific, Lewis, Pierce, Thurston,
- 15 Grays Harbor, Mason, Jefferson, Clallam, and Kitsap.
- 16 (c) Region III shall include the following counties: King,
- 17 Snohomish, Skagit, Whatcom, San Juan, and Island.
- 18 (2) Each departmental administration and division shall reorganize

Sec. 2. RCW 43.20A.090 and 1994 sp.s. c 7 s 515 are each amended to read as follows:

The secretary shall appoint a deputy secretary, a department 5 6 personnel director, and ((such)) no more than three assistant secretaries ((as shall be needed)) to administer the department. 7 deputy secretary shall have charge and general supervision of the 8 department in the absence or disability of the secretary, and in case 9 of a vacancy in the office of secretary, shall continue in charge of 10 11 the department until a successor is appointed and qualified, or until 12 the governor shall appoint an acting secretary. ((The secretary shall appoint an assistant secretary to administer the juvenile 13 14 rehabilitation responsibilities required of the department by chapters 13.04, 13.40, and 13.50 RCW.)) The officers appointed under this 15 section, and exempt from the provisions of the state civil service law 16 ((by the terms of RCW 41.06.076)), shall be paid salaries to be fixed 17 18 by the governor in accordance with the procedure established by law for 19 the fixing of salaries for officers exempt from the operation of the 20 state civil service law.

21 **Sec. 3.** RCW 71.24.360 and 2005 c 504 s 805 are each amended to 22 read as follows:

The department may establish new regional support network boundaries in any part of the state where more than one network chooses not to respond to, or is unable to substantially meet the requirements of, the request for qualifications under section 4, chapter 503, Laws of 2005 or where a regional support network is subject to reprocurement under section 6, chapter 503, Laws of 2005. The department may establish no fewer than ((eight)) three and no more than ((fourteen)) six regional support networks under this chapter. ((No entity shall be responsible for more than three regional support networks.))
