- AN ACT Relating to gathering signatures for an initiative or referendum at stand alone stores and retail stores that are located in commercial retail complexes; and adding a new section to chapter 29A.72 RCW.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 29A.72 RCW to read as follows:
  - (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, any person who is gathering signatures for an initiative measure or referendum filed with the secretary of state is prohibited within a presumptively reasonable minimum distance of fifteen feet from entrances and exits that serve stand alone stores or retail stores that are located in commercial retail complexes.
  - (2) The property owner of a stand alone store or retail store located in a commercial retail complex may grant a person who is gathering signatures for an initiative measure or referendum filed with the secretary of state permission to be closer than fifteen feet from
