1 AN ACT Relating to modernizing the criteria for membership on the
2 board of natural resources without altering the number of members; and
3 amending RCW 43.30.205.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.30.205 and 2003 c 334 s 104 are each amended to
6 read as follows:

7 (1) The board shall consist of six members:

8 (a) The governor or the governor's designee((~~r~~));

9 (b) The superintendent of public instruction((~~r~~));

10 (c) The commissioner ((~~of public lands, the dean of the college of~~
11 forest resources of the University of Washington, the dean of the
12 college of agriculture of Washington State University,));

13 (d) The president of the University of Washington or the
14 president's designee;

15 (e) The president of Washington State University or the president's
16 designee; and

17 (f) A representative of those counties that contain state forest
18 lands acquired or transferred under RCW 79.22.010, 79.22.040, and
19 79.22.020.

1 (2)(a) The county representative on the board shall be selected by
2 the legislative authorities of those counties that contain state forest
3 lands acquired or transferred under RCW 79.22.010, 79.22.040, and
4 79.22.020. The eligible counties shall utilize a private statewide
5 association representing the interests of the legislative authorities
6 and executives of Washington counties to coordinate selection of the
7 county representative. In the selection of the county representative,
8 each participating county shall have one vote. (~~The Washington state~~
9 ~~association of counties shall conduct a meeting for the purpose of~~
10 ~~making the selection and shall notify the board of the selection.~~)

11 (b) The county representative (~~shall~~) must be a duly elected
12 member of a county legislative authority who shall serve a term of four
13 years unless the representative should leave office for any reason.
14 The initial term shall begin on July 1, 1986.
