- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.63.020 and 2009 c 485 s 6 are each amended to read 6 as follows:
 - Failure to perform any act required or the performance of any act prohibited by this title or an equivalent administrative regulation or local law, ordinance, regulation, or resolution relating to traffic including parking, standing, stopping, and pedestrian offenses, is designated as a traffic infraction and may not be classified as a criminal offense, except for an offense contained in the following provisions of this title or a violation of an equivalent administrative regulation or local law, ordinance, regulation, or resolution, or a local law, ordinance, regulation or resolution as described in this section:
