- 1 AN ACT Relating to information included in the voters' pamphlet;
- 2. and adding a new section to chapter 29A.32 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 29A.32 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- For each voters' pamphlet prepared for the general election, the 7 office of financial management shall prepare the following charts:
  - (1) A pie chart showing the amount of state revenues generated by major type of tax;
- 10 (2) A table comparing the general fund-state revenues with the 11 general fund-state expenditures by county;
- (3) A pie chart showing general fund-state expenditures by major 12 13 expenditure category;
- 14 (4) A bar chart showing the percent of income paid in federal, 15 state, and local taxes by income brackets, as follows:
  - (a) Under twenty thousand dollars;

- 17 (b) Between twenty thousand dollars and thirty thousand dollars;
- (c) Between thirty thousand dollars and forty thousand dollars; 18
- (d) Between forty thousand dollars and fifty thousand dollars; 19
