1 AN ACT Relating to surplus line coverage; and amending RCW 2 48.15.040.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 48.15.040 and 1983 1st ex.s. c 32 s 4 are each amended 5 to read as follows:

6 If certain insurance coverages cannot be procured from authorized 7 insurers, such coverages, hereinafter designated as "surplus lines," 8 may be procured from unauthorized insurers subject to the following 9 conditions:

10 (1) The insurance must be procured through a licensed surplus line 11 broker.

(2) The insurance must not be procurable, after diligent effort has
been made to do so from among a majority of the insurers authorized to
transact that kind of insurance in this state.

(3) Coverage ((shall)) <u>must</u> not be procured from an unauthorized insurer for the purpose of securing a lower premium rate than would be accepted by any authorized insurer nor to secure any other competitive advantage. 1 (4) The commissioner may by ((regulation)) rule establish the 2 degree of effort required to comply with subsections (2) and (3) of 3 this section.

(5) At the time of the procuring of any such insurance ((an 4 affidavit)) a declaration setting forth the facts referred to in 5 subsections (2) and (3) of this section must be executed by the surplus 6 line broker. Such ((affidavit)) declaration ((shall)) must be ((filed 7 8 with)) submitted to the commissioner within thirty days after the insurance is procured. The declaration may be in electronic, digital, 9 or other format or form as designated by the commissioner. The 10 declaration must include the following certification: 11
