- 5 We, your Memorialists, the Senate and House of Representatives of 6 the State of Washington, in legislative session assembled, respectfully represent and petition as follows: 7
- 8 WHEREAS, The state of Washington imposes a sales tax rather than a state income tax; and 9
- WHEREAS, Six other states impose a sales tax with little or no 10 11 state income tax; and
- WHEREAS, The federal tax code allows a deduction for state income 12 taxes, resulting in a disadvantage for taxpayers in states that do not 13 14 impose an income tax; and
- 15 WHEREAS, For the past several years, taxpayers have been given the 16 choice of deducting their state income tax or a state sales tax on 17 their federal returns; and
- 18 WHEREAS, The impact of this tax break amounts to a reduction in taxable income by two billion two hundred ninety million dollars, or 19 about two thousand three hundred fifty dollars per return; and 20
