4 Sec. 1. RCW 2.64.020 and 2005 c 15 s 1 are each amended to read as follows:

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

- (1) The commission shall consist of ((eleven)) fourteen members. ((One)) Two members shall be ((a)) judges selected by and from the court of appeals judges; ((one)) two members shall be ((a)) judges selected by and from the superior court judges; ((one)) two members shall be ((a)) judges selected by and from the limited jurisdiction court judges; two members shall be selected by the state bar association and be admitted to the practice of law in this state; and six members shall be nonlawyers appointed by the governor. The term of each member of the commission shall be four years.
- 15 (2) No commission member or alternate who participates in an 16 investigation or initial proceeding leading to a finding of probable 17 cause may participate in any further proceedings on that cause,
