AN ACT Relating to the effect of zoning ordinances on motor vehicle collection and restoration; adding a new section to chapter 35.21 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 35.63 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 35A.63 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 36.70 RCW; and adding a new section to chapter 36.70A RCW.

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 35.21 RCW to read as follows:
- 9 (1) Except as provided under subsection (2) of this section, a city 10 or town shall not enact, enforce, or maintain an ordinance, development 11 regulation, zoning regulation, or official control, policy, or 12 administrative practice that prohibits the hobby of collecting and 13 restoring motor vehicles, including any of the following:
- 14 (a) Repairing or modifying motor vehicles that are undergoing 15 restoration; or
- 16 (b) Maintaining motor vehicles as a source of parts for motor vehicles undergoing restoration.
