1 AN ACT Relating to the designation of certain state routes as  
2 highways of statewide significance; and adding a new section to chapter  
3 47.05 RCW.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 47.05 RCW  
6 to read as follows:

7 The following highways are of statewide significance:

8 (1) That portion of state route number 11 that runs from Interstate  
9 5 to 12th Street near the Alaska Marine Highway System ferry terminal  
10 in Bellingham;

11 (2) That portion of state route number 529 from the port of Everett  
12 north to Interstate 5 near Marysville; and

13 (3) State route number 599, as defined in RCW 47.17.808.
