- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 47.05 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 The following highways are of statewide significance:
- 8 (1) That portion of state route number 11 that runs from Interstate
- 9 5 to 12th Street near the Alaska Marine Highway System ferry terminal
- 10 in Bellingham;
- 11 (2) That portion of state route number 529 from the port of Everett
- 12 north to Interstate 5 near Marysville; and
- 13 (3) State route number 599, as defined in RCW 47.17.808.
