- (15) Sue and be sued as a commission, without individual liability for acts of the commission within the scope of the powers conferred upon it by this chapter;
- (16) Serve as liaison with the liquor control board on behalf of the commission and not for any individual producer;
- (17) Until July 1, 2009, receive such gifts, grants, and endowments from public or private sources as may be made from time to time, in trust or otherwise, for the use and benefit of the purposes of the commission and expend the same or any income therefrom according to the terms of the gifts, grants, or endowments. Reimbursement shall be made from the assessments of the commission, and shall not be made by the department.
- **Sec. 114.** RCW 16.67.070 and 2002 c 313 s 81 are each amended to read as follows:
- 35 (1) In the event a position on the commission becomes vacant due to 36 resignation, disqualification, death, or for any other reason, the

1 unexpired term of such position shall be filled by the director 2 forthwith.

- (2) Each member of the commission shall be compensated in accordance with RCW 43.03.230.
- (3) Each member or employee shall be reimbursed for actual travel expenses incurred in carrying out the provisions of this chapter as defined by the commission in rule. 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NEW SECTION. Sec. 116. By July 1, 2010, the governor shall recommend to the legislature which of the boards and commissions, created either by statute or by action of the executive branch, shall receive state funding, those whose activities shall be suspended, and those which shall be terminated either by legislative or executive branch action.

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
