## SENATE BILL 5744

State of Washington 61st Legislature 2009 Regular Session

1 AN ACT Relating to public utility tax for log transportation 2 businesses; amending RCW 82.16.010 and 82.16.020; and providing an 3 effective date.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 82.16.010 and 2007 c 6 s 1023 are each amended to read 6 as follows:

For the purposes of this chapter, unless otherwise required by the context:

9 (1) "Railroad business" means the business of operating any 10 railroad, by whatever power operated, for public use in the conveyance 11 of persons or property for hire. It shall not, however, include any 12 business herein defined as an urban transportation business.

13 (2) "Express business" means the business of carrying property for 14 public hire on the line of any common carrier operated in this state, 15 when such common carrier is not owned or leased by the person engaging 16 in such business.

(3) "Railroad car business" means the business of operating stock
 cars, furniture cars, refrigerator cars, fruit cars, poultry cars, tank
 cars, sleeping cars, parlor cars, buffet cars, tourist cars, or any

other kinds of cars used for transportation of property or persons upon the line of any railroad operated in this state when such railroad is not owned or leased by the person engaging in such business.

4 (4) "Water distribution business" means the business of operating 5 a plant or system for the distribution of water for hire or sale.

6 (5) "Light and power business" means the business of operating a 7 plant or system for the generation, production or distribution of 8 electrical energy for hire or sale and/or for the wheeling of 9 electricity for others.

10 (6) "Telegraph business" means the business of affording 11 telegraphic communication for hire.

12 (7) "Gas distribution business" means the business of operating a 13 plant or system for the production or distribution for hire or sale of 14 gas, whether manufactured or natural.

15 (8) "Motor transportation business" means the business (except urban transportation business) of operating any motor propelled vehicle 16 17 by which persons or property of others are conveyed for hire, and includes, but is not limited to, the operation of any motor propelled 18 19 vehicle as an auto transportation company (except urban transportation business), common carrier or contract carrier as defined by RCW 20 21 81.68.010 and 81.80.010((: <u>PROVIDED</u>, That)). <u>However</u>, "motor transportation business" shall not mean or include: (a) A log 22 transportation business; or (b) the transportation of logs or other 23 24 forest products exclusively upon private roads or private highways.

25 (9) "Urban transportation business" means the business of operating 26 any vehicle for public use in the conveyance of persons or property for 27 hire, insofar as (a) operating entirely within the corporate limits of 28 any city or town, or within five miles of the corporate limits thereof, 29 or (b) operating entirely within and between cities and towns whose 30 corporate limits are not more than five miles apart or within five miles of the corporate limits of either thereof. Included herein, but 31 32 without limiting the scope hereof, is the business of operating passenger vehicles of every type and also the business of operating 33 cartage, pickup, or delivery services, including in such services the 34 35 collection and distribution of property arriving from or destined to a 36 point within or without the state, whether or not such collection or 37 distribution be made by the person performing a local or interstate line-haul of such property. 38

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1 (10) <u>"Log transportation business" means the business of</u> 2 transporting logs by truck, other than exclusively upon private roads.

(11)(a) "Public service business" means any of the businesses 3 defined in subsections (1), (2), (3), (4), (5), (6), (7), (8), ((and)) 4 (9), and 10 of this section, or any business subject to control by the 5 state, or having the powers of eminent domain and the duties incident 6 thereto, or any business hereafter declared by the legislature to be of 7 8 a public service nature, except telephone business and low-level 9 radioactive waste site operating companies as redefined in RCW 10 81.04.010. It includes, among others, without limiting the scope 11 hereof: Airplane transportation, boom, dock, ferry, pipe line, toll 12 bridge, toll logging road, water transportation and wharf businesses.

13 (b) The definitions in this subsection (((10))) (11)(b) apply 14 throughout this subsection (((10))) (11).

(i) "Competitive telephone service" has the same meaning as in RCW82.04.065.

(ii) "Network telephone service" means the providing by any person 17 of access to a telephone network, telephone network switching service, 18 19 toll service, or coin telephone services, or the providing of 20 telephonic, video, data, or similar communication or transmission for 21 hire, via a telephone network, toll line or channel, cable, microwave, 22 or similar communication or transmission system. "Network telephone service" includes the provision of transmission to and from the site of 23 24 an internet provider via a telephone network, toll line or channel, cable, microwave, or similar communication or transmission system. 25 26 "Network telephone service" does not include the providing of 27 competitive telephone service, the providing of cable television service, the providing of broadcast services by radio or television 28 stations, nor the provision of internet service as defined in RCW 29 30 82.04.297, including the reception of dial-in connection, provided at the site of the internet service provider. 31

(iii) "Telephone business" means the business of providing network
 telephone service. It includes cooperative or farmer line telephone
 companies or associations operating an exchange.

35 (iv) "Telephone service" means competitive telephone service or 36 network telephone service, or both, as defined in (b)(i) and (ii) of 37 this subsection.

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((<del>(11)</del>)) <u>(12)</u> "Tugboat business" means the business of operating
 tugboats, towboats, wharf boats or similar vessels in the towing or
 pushing of vessels, barges or rafts for hire.

4 ((<del>(12)</del>)) <u>(13)</u> "Gross income" means the value proceeding or accruing 5 from the performance of the particular public service or transportation 6 business involved, including operations incidental thereto, but without 7 any deduction on account of the cost of the commodity furnished or 8 sold, the cost of materials used, labor costs, interest, discount, 9 delivery costs, taxes, or any other expense whatsoever paid or accrued 10 and without any deduction on account of losses.

11 ((<del>(13)</del>)) <u>(14)</u> The meaning attributed, in chapter 82.04 RCW, to the 12 term "tax year," "person," "value proceeding or accruing," "business," 13 "engaging in business," "in this state," "within this state," "cash 14 discount" and "successor" shall apply equally in the provisions of this 15 chapter.

16 **Sec. 2.** RCW 82.16.020 and 1996 c 150 s 2 are each amended to read 17 as follows:

(1) There is levied and there shall be collected from every person a tax for the act or privilege of engaging within this state in any one or more of the businesses herein mentioned. The tax shall be equal to the gross income of the business, multiplied by the rate set out after the business, as follows:

(a) Express, sewerage collection, and telegraph businesses: Threeand six-tenths percent;

(b) Light and power business: Three and sixty-two one-hundredths percent;

27 (c) Gas distribution business: Three and six-tenths percent;

(d) Urban transportation business: Six-tenths of one percent;

(e) Vessels under sixty-five feet in length, except tugboats,
 operating upon the waters within the state: Six-tenths of one percent;

31 (f) Motor transportation, railroad, railroad car, and tugboat 32 businesses, and all public service businesses other than ones mentioned 33 above: One and eight-tenths of one percent;

34 (g) Water distribution business: Four and seven-tenths percent;
35 (h) Log transportation business: One and twenty-eight hundredths

36 <u>percent</u>.

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(2) An additional tax is imposed equal to the rate specified in RCW
 82.02.030 multiplied by the tax payable under subsection (1) of this
 section.

4 (3) Twenty percent of the moneys collected under subsection (1) of 5 this section on water distribution businesses and sixty percent of the 6 moneys collected under subsection (1) of this section on sewerage 7 collection businesses shall be deposited in the public works assistance 8 account created in RCW 43.155.050.

9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. This act takes effect August 1, 2009.

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
