- NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. (1) A contract for a wireless communications 4 5 device may be canceled upon the request of a subscriber for any reason up to thirty days after entering into the contract without the 6 subscriber incurring any early termination fees.
  - (2) Any early termination fees beyond the initial thirty-day period must be prorated equally among the remaining term of the wireless communications device contract.

The legislature finds that the practices NEW SECTION. 12 covered by this chapter are matters vitally affecting the public 13 interest for the purpose of applying the consumer protection act, 14 chapter 19.86 RCW. A violation of this chapter is not reasonable in 15 relation to the development and preservation of business and is an unfair or deceptive act in trade or commerce and an unfair method of 16 17 competition for the purpose of applying the consumer protection act, 18 chapter 19.86 RCW.
