- 1 AN ACT Relating to creating the community agricultural worker
- 2 safety grant program; adding a new section to chapter 15.04 RCW;
- 3 creating a new section; and providing an expiration date.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that agricultural
- 6 workers are challenged not only in finding full-time, year-round work,
- 7 but also face difficulties in upgrading their agricultural skills. The
- 8 legislature also finds that the agricultural industry's demand for
- 9 skilled workers far outnumbers the current supply. In addition, the
- 10 legislature finds that despite recent advances in the safety of
- 11 agricultural production, additional training of agricultural workers
- 12 should assist the agricultural sector in ongoing efforts to reduce
- 13 occupational injuries.
- 14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 15.04 RCW
- 15 to read as follows:
- 16 Subject to the availability of amounts appropriated for this
- 17 specific purpose, the department shall administer the community
- 18 agricultural worker safety grant program, to be implemented by the

- 501(c)(3) nonprofit opportunities industrialization center 1 2 Washington. As grant recipient, the center shall work with the agricultural industry to provide practical, hands-on training for the 3 state's agricultural workers in tractor and farm machinery skills and 4 safety, pesticide training, adult basic skills, civics, English as a 5 6 second language, commercial drivers' licensing, and other related topics. The grant recipient may receive up to two hundred fifty 7 8 thousand dollars per year.
- 9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** This act expires July 1, 2013.
