- 1 AN ACT Relating to the sale of surplus salmon from state
- 2 hatcheries; creating a new section; and providing an expiration date.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** (1) The department of fish and wildlife must 5 work with appropriate stakeholders including, at minimum, regional
- 6 fisheries enhancement groups, food banks, current and past surplus
- 7 salmon disposal contractors, commercial and recreational fishers,
- 8 tribes, and commercial aquaculture in order to facilitate the
- 9 disposition of surplus salmon, including eggs and carcasses, in the
- 10 manner that best utilizes the resource and enhances both: Revenues to
- 11 regional fisheries enhancement groups authorized under RCW 77.95.060;
- 12 and the provision of nutrients to food banks. The department of fish
- 13 and wildlife must provide a summary of these discussions, outcomes, and
- 14 any legislative recommendations to the appropriate committees of the
- 15 legislature by November 1, 2010.
- 16 (2) The department of fish and wildlife must carry out the
- 17 requirements of this section within existing funds.
