## (SUBSTITUTED FOR - SEE 2ND SUB)

Restricts the use of bisphenol A.

Requires the department of ecology to, by July 1, 2012, conduct an alternatives assessment for bisphenol A in cans, jars, or other containers that are used to hold liquids, food, or beverages primarily for human consumption and are not prohibited under this act.

Requires a manufacturer of products that are restricted under this act to notify persons that sell the manufacturer's products in this state about the provisions of this act no less than ninety days before the effective date of the restrictions.

Requires a manufacturer that produces, sells, or distributes a product prohibited from manufacture, sale, or distribution in this state under this act to recall the product and reimburse the retailer or any other purchaser for the product.

Provides penalties.
