(SEE ALSO PROPOSED 2ND SUB)

Directs the early learning advisory council, in collaboration with the office of the superintendent of public instruction, to convene a work group to develop and field test a statewide kindergarten assessment process to: (1) Provide parents and teachers with information about a child's knowledge, skills, and abilities upon entering kindergarten in order to inform instruction for the child;

- (2) Facilitate communication with parents about what children are learning and to empower parents to assist their children; and
- (3) Provide feedback to early learning programs to enable continuous improvement, support transitions, and improve alignment between early learning programs and kindergarten classrooms.

Requires the kindergarten assessment process to be field-tested in selected schools and districts during the 2010-11 school year.

Requires the office of the superintendent of public instruction to encourage all school districts to implement the statewide kindergarten assessment process beginning in the 2011-12 school year.
