HB 2580-S - DIGEST

(AS OF HOUSE 2ND READING 3/19/10)

Declares that, in 2008, the legislature enacted comprehensive legislation in support of rigorous, high-quality secondary career and technical education.

Continues this support and addresses lingering issues regarding recognition of career and technical courses by community and technical colleges.

Prohibits a college from charging a student more than a standard transcription fee to accept an agreed-upon career and technical education course for college credit.
