# FINAL BILL REPORT HB 1486

Synopsis as Enacted

**Brief Description**: Authorizing Washington pharmacies to fill prescriptions written by advanced registered nurse practitioners in other states.

**Sponsors**: Representatives Green, Jinkins, Cody, Hinkle, Moeller, Bailey, Schmick, Clibborn, Kelley and Condotta.

## House Committee on Health Care & Wellness Senate Committee on Health & Long-Term Care

### Background:

It is unlawful to possess, deliver, or dispense a legend drug or controlled substance except pursuant to a prescription issued by health care professionals who are licensed in Washington; e.g., physicians, dentists, and advanced registered nurse practitioners. Additionally, Washington pharmacies may honor prescriptions written by the following professions from other states:

- physicians;
- osteopathic physicians and surgeons;
- dentists:
- podiatric physicians and surgeons; and
- veterinarians

In 2010 the Legislature added out-of-state advanced registered nurse practitioners to this list with respect to legend drugs, but not controlled substances.

#### **Summary**:

Washington pharmacies may honor prescriptions written by out-of-state advanced registered nurse practitioners with respect to controlled substances.
