## ENGROSSED SUBSTITUTE HOUSE BILL 1009

AN ACT Relating to the authority of state agencies to enter into agreements with the federal government under the endangered species act; adding a new section to chapter 77.12 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 43.30 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 43.21A RCW; and adding a new section to chapter 79A.05 RCW.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

7 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 77.12 RCW 8 to read as follows:

9 Before the department seeks or dedicates funding to develop a new habitat conservation plan under the endangered species act, 16 U.S.C. 10 Sec. 1531 et seq., or to develop a major amendment to an existing 11 12 habitat conservation plan, the department must inform the appropriate 13 committees of the legislature regarding the proposed timeline and budget and solicit the recommendations of the committees regarding 14 15 public process and notification. The information provided by the 16 department must include an economic analysis comparing the decision to enter into a habitat conservation plan with the decision to not enter 17 18 into a habitat conservation plan.

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NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 43.30 RCW under the subchapter heading "PART 5" to read as follows:

Before the department seeks or dedicates funding to develop a new 3 habitat conservation plan under the endangered species act, 16 U.S.C. 4 5 Sec. 1531 et seq., or to develop a major amendment to an existing habitat conservation plan, the department must inform the appropriate 6 7 committees of the legislature regarding the proposed timeline and budget and solicit the recommendations of the committees regarding 8 public process and notification. The information provided by the 9 10 department must include an economic analysis comparing the decision to enter into a habitat conservation plan with the decision to not enter 11 12 into a habitat conservation plan.

13 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 43.21A RCW 14 to read as follows:

15 Before the department seeks or dedicates funding to develop a new 16 habitat conservation plan under the endangered species act, 16 U.S.C. 17 Sec. 1531 et seq., or to develop a major amendment to an existing habitat conservation plan, the department must inform the appropriate 18 19 committees of the legislature regarding the proposed timeline and 20 budget and solicit the recommendations of the committees regarding 21 public process and notification. The information provided by the department must include an economic analysis comparing the decision to 22 23 enter into a habitat conservation plan with the decision to not enter 24 into a habitat conservation plan.

25 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 4. A new section is added to chapter 79A.05 RCW 26 to read as follows:

Before the commission seeks or dedicates funding to develop a new 27 habitat conservation plan under the endangered species act, 16 U.S.C. 28 29 Sec. 1531 et seq., or to develop a major amendment to an existing 30 habitat conservation plan, the commission must inform the appropriate committees of the legislature regarding the proposed timeline and 31 budget and solicit the recommendations of the committees regarding 32 public process and notification. The information provided by the 33 34 commission must include an economic analysis comparing the decision to
