- 1 AN ACT Relating to requiring verification of employment eligibility
- 2 by the state and its political subdivisions; and adding a new section
- 3 to chapter 41.04 RCW.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 41.04 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (1) The legislature finds that the federal immigration and 8 nationality act makes it unlawful to hire for employment an alien
- 9 knowing the alien is an unauthorized alien with respect to such
- 10 employment. The legislature therefore intends to require the state and
- 11 all counties, cities, towns, and other political subdivisions thereof
- 12 to verify the employment eligibility of individuals hired for
- 13 employment.
- 14 (2) In accordance with the federal immigration and nationality act,
- 15 the state and all counties, cities, towns, and other political
- 16 subdivisions thereof shall complete an employment eligibility
- 17 verification form for each individual hired for employment. The state
- 18 and all counties, cities, towns, and other political subdivisions

thereof shall also use the e-verify program administered by the United States citizenship and immigration services to confirm each individual's employment eligibility.

5 6 (3) For the purpose of this section, "unauthorized alien" means the same as in section 274A of the immigration and nationality act (8 U.S.C. Sec. 1324a).
