- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 9A.56.200 and 2002 c 85 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 (1) A person is guilty of robbery in the first degree if:
- 7 (a) In the commission of a robbery or of immediate flight 8 therefrom, he or she:
- 9 (i) Is armed with a deadly weapon; or
- 10 (ii) Displays what appears to be a firearm or other deadly weapon;
- 11 or
- 12 (iii) Inflicts bodily injury; ((or))
- 13 (b) He or she commits a robbery within and against a financial
- 14 institution as defined in RCW 7.88.010 or 35.38.060; or
- 15 (c) He or she commits a robbery of a pharmacy as defined in RCW
- 16 <u>18.64.011</u>. "Pharmacy" includes only the portion of the building or
- 17 store that is licensed by the board of pharmacy.
