- NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 29A.72 RCW to read as follows:
 - (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, any person who is gathering signatures for an initiative measure or referendum filed with the secretary of state is prohibited within a presumptively reasonable minimum distance of fifteen feet from entrances and exits that serve stand alone stores or retail stores that are located in commercial retail complexes.
- 14 (2) The property owner of a stand alone store or retail store 15 located in a commercial retail complex may grant a person who is 16 gathering signatures for an initiative measure or referendum filed with 17 the secretary of state permission to be closer than fifteen feet from
