- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that Washington is
- 5 well known as the espresso capital of the country. The coffee industry
- 6 is a vital part of the Washington state economy that provides jobs and
- 7 morning motivation for many state citizens. Over half of the states in
- 8 the country have established a state beverage. The official
- 9 designation is a desirable promotional tool that Washington businesses
