- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 9A.44 RCW 7 to read as follows:
 - (1) A person is guilty of criminal trespass on school property by a sex offender if he or she is a covered offender and knowingly enters the premises of a school.
 - (2) This section does not apply if the person:
- (a) Is eighteen years of age and is a student attending or planning 12 13 to attend the school; or
- 14 (b) Is the parent or legal guardian of a child who attends the 15 school and has written permission from the school principal or 16 administrator to enter school premises for a specified purpose,
- including, but not limited to, attending a parent-teacher conference or 17
- 18 participating in other educational or recreational activities.

- 1 (3)(a) Except as provided in (b) of this subsection, criminal trespass on school property by a sex offender is a class C felony.
- 3 (b) Criminal trespass on school property by a sex offender is a 4 class B felony if the person has previously been convicted under this 5 section.
- 6 **Sec. 2.** RCW 9A.44.190 and 2006 c 126 s 4 are each amended to read 7 as follows:

8 As used in this section and RCW 9A.44.193 ((and)), 9A.44.196, and 9 section 1 of this act:

- (1) "Covered entity" means any public facility or private facility whose primary purpose, at any time, is to provide for the education, care, or recreation of a child or children, including but not limited to community and recreational centers, playgrounds, schools, swimming pools, and state or municipal parks.
- 15 (2) "Child" means a person under the age of eighteen, unless the 16 context clearly indicates that the term is otherwise defined in 17 statute.
 - (3) "Public facility" means a facility operated by a unit of local or state government, or by a nonprofit organization.
- 20 (4) "Schools" means public and private schools, but does not include home-based instruction as defined in RCW 28A.225.010.
 - (5) "Covered offender" means a person required to register under RCW 9A.44.130 who is eighteen years of age or older, who is not under the jurisdiction of the juvenile rehabilitation authority or currently serving a special sex offender disposition alternative, whose risk level classification has been assessed at a risk level II or a risk level III pursuant to RCW 72.09.345, and who, at any time, has been convicted of one or more of the following offenses:
 - (a) Rape of a child in the first, second, and third degree; child molestation in the first, second, and third degree; indecent liberties against a child under age fifteen; sexual misconduct with a minor in the first and second degree; incest in the first and second degree; luring with sexual motivation; possession of depictions of minors engaged in sexually explicit conduct; dealing in depictions of minors engaged in sexually explicit conduct; bringing into the state depictions of minors engaged in sexually explicit conduct; sexual
