- 7 No state-elected official or municipal officer may speak or appear
- 8 in a public service announcement that is broadcast, shown, of
- 9 distributed in any form whatsoever during the period beginning
- 10 ((January 1st)) at the time the official or officer files a statement
- 11 of organization under RCW 42.17A.205 and continuing through the general
- 12 election if that official or officer is a candidate. If the official
- or officer does not control the broadcast, showing, or distribution of
- 14 a public service announcement in which he or she speaks or appears,
- 15 then the official or officer shall contractually limit the use of the
- 16 public service announcement to be consistent with this section prior to
- 17 participating in the public service announcement. This section does
