1 AN ACT Relating to allowing a registered tow truck operator to 2. reimpound a vehicle that has been redeemed from storage or purchased at auction and not removed from the operator's business premises; and 3 amending RCW 46.55.035. 4

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.55.035 and 2010 c 56 s 1 are each amended to read 6 7 as follows:
 - (1) No registered tow truck operator may:

- (a) Except as authorized under RCW 46.55.037, ask for or receive any compensation, gratuity, reward, or promise thereof from a person 10 having control or possession of private property or from an agent of 11 12 the person authorized to sign an impound authorization, for or on account of the impounding of a vehicle; 13
 - (b) Be beneficially interested in a contract, agreement, understanding that may be made by or between a person having control or possession of private property and an agent of the person authorized to sign an impound authorization. A registered tow truck operator may, however, on the operator's own authorization, reimpound a previously

impounded vehicle that has been redeemed from storage or purchased at auction and left by the person redeeming or purchasing the vehicle at the operator's place of business for more than twenty-four hours;

- (c) Have a financial, equitable, or ownership interest in a firm, partnership, association, or corporation whose functions include acting as an agent or a representative of a property owner for the purpose of signing impound authorizations;
- $(d)((\frac{1}{2}))$ Enter into any contract or agreement or offer any program that provides an incentive to a person authorized to order a private impound under RCW 46.55.080 that is related to the authorization of an impound or a number of impounds.
- $((\frac{(ii)}{(ii)}))$ (i) The incentives prohibited by this section may be either monetary or nonmonetary things of value, such as gifts or prizes which are contingent on, or as a reward for the authorization of impounds.

- $((\frac{\text{(iv)}}{\text{)}}))$ (iii) The provision of the actual physical signs required by this chapter to be posted on private property and the labor and materials for placing them is not a violation of this section.
- (2) This section does not prohibit the registered tow truck operator from collecting the costs of towing, storage, or other services rendered during the course of towing, removing, impounding, or storing of an impounded vehicle as provided by RCW 46.55.120.
 - (3) A violation of this section is a gross misdemeanor.
