- 1 AN ACT Relating to criminalizing the failure to report the death or
- 2 disappearance of a child within a specified time by certain persons
- 3 responsible for the care of the child; adding a new chapter to Title 9A
- 4 RCW; and prescribing penalties.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** Any parent, legal guardian, or caregiver who
- 7 knowingly fails to notify law enforcement within forty-eight hours of
- 8 learning that a child, in his or her care and less than thirteen years
- 9 of age, is missing is guilty of a gross misdemeanor.
- 10 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** Any parent, legal guardian, or caregiver who
- 11 knowingly fails to notify law enforcement within six hours of learning
- 12 of the death of a minor child in his or her care is guilty of a class
- 13 C felony.
- 14 NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. Sections 1 and 2 of this act constitute a
- 15 new chapter in Title 9A RCW.
