- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 70.129.105 and 1997 c 392 s 211 are each amended to read as follows:
- 7 (1) No long-term care facility or nursing facility licensed under 8 chapter 18.51 RCW shall require or request residents to sign waivers 9 of:
- 10 <u>(a) P</u>otential liability for losses of personal property or 11 injury((, or to sign waivers of));
- 12 <u>(b) R</u>esidents' rights set forth in this chapter or in the 13 applicable licensing or certification laws; or
- 14 <u>(c) Any rights set forth in the vulnerable adults statute, chapter</u> 15 74.34 RCW.
- 16 (2) This section does not prohibit a facility from asking residents
 17 to agree to binding dispute resolution, if:
- 18 <u>(a) The agreement is in writing;</u>

(c) The request is made after the dispute arises.

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<u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** This act applies prospectively only and not retroactively. It applies only to written documents signed on or after the effective date of this section.

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
