1 AN ACT Relating to expenditures for works of art; amending RCW 2 43.17.200; creating a new section; and providing an expiration date.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 The legislature recognizes one of its NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. 5 foremost duties is the prioritization and wise use of taxpayer funds. б The legislature concludes that the placement of art at a correctional 7 facility is not a priority over other state programs such as education 8 and public safety, and further expenditures on such activities 9 constitute a misuse and waste of taxpayer funds. To prevent such 10 misuse of taxpayer dollars, the legislature hereby intends to prohibit 11 the expenditure of public funds on placement of works of art in the special commitment center on McNeil Island, secure community transition 12 13 facilities and other halfway houses operated by the department of social and health services to house persons subject to the community 14 15 protection act of 1990, and facilities operated by the department of 16 corrections.

17 **Sec. 2.** RCW 43.17.200 and 2005 c 36 s 4 are each amended to read 18 as follows:

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All state agencies including all state departments, boards, 1 2 councils, commissions, and quasi public corporations shall allocate, as a nondeductible item, out of any moneys appropriated for the original 3 4 construction of any public building, an amount of one-half of one percent of the appropriation to be expended by the Washington state 5 6 arts commission for the acquisition of works of art; however, no moneys shall be expended on the acquisition or placement of works of art in 7 the special commitment center on McNeil Island, secure community 8 9 transition facilities and other halfway houses operated by the department of social and health services to house persons subject to 10 the community protection act of 1990, or any facility operated by the 11 department of corrections; moneys allocated for this purpose shall 12 instead be excluded from the cost of construction. 13 The works of art may be placed on public lands, integral to or attached to a public 14 15 building or structure, detached within or outside a public building or structure, part of a portable exhibition or collection, part of a 16 temporary exhibition, or loaned or exhibited in other public 17 facilities. In addition to the cost of the works of art, the one-half 18 19 of one percent of the appropriation as provided herein shall be used to 20 provide for the administration of the visual arts program, including 21 conservation of the state art collection, by the Washington state arts 22 commission and all costs for installation of the works of art. For the 23 purpose of this section building shall not include highway construction 24 sheds, warehouses or other buildings of a temporary nature.

25 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 3. This act expires June 30, 2013.

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
