1 AN ACT Relating to access to K-12 campuses for occupational or 2 educational information; and amending RCW 28A.230.180.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 28A.230.180 and 1980 c 96 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:

6 (1) If the board of directors of a school district provides access 7 to the campus and the student information directory to persons or 8 groups which make students aware of occupational or educational 9 options, the board shall provide access on the same basis to official 10 recruiting representatives of the military forces of the state and the 11 United States for the purpose of informing students of educational and 12 career opportunities available in the military.

13 (2) If the board of directors of a school district chooses to 14 provide access to the campus under the authority of subsection (1) of 15 this section, it must provide the persons, groups, and representatives 16 an opportunity to access the campus on at least three separate dates 17 during the school year. Each of the three dates shall be separated by

1 <u>at least one month.</u>
