RCW 9A.56.200 and 2002 c 85 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows: (1) A person is guilty of robbery in the first degree if: 6 7 (a) In the commission of a robbery or of immediate flight therefrom, he or she: 8 9 (i) Is armed with a deadly weapon; or 10 (ii) Displays what appears to be a firearm or other deadly weapon; 11 or 12 (iii) Inflicts bodily injury; ((or)) 13 (b) He or she commits a robbery within and against a financial 14 institution as defined in RCW 7.88.010 or 35.38.060; or 15 (c) He or she commits a robbery of a pharmacy as defined in RCW 16 18.64.011(21). 17 (2) Robbery in the first degree is a class A felony.
