- AN ACT Relating to creating the Walla Walla state veterans' home;
- 2 adding a new section to chapter 72.36 RCW; and providing a contingent
- 3 effective date.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 72.36 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 There shall be established and maintained in this state a branch of
- 8 the state soldiers' home, under the name of the "Walla Walla state
- 9 veterans' home, " which shall be a home for veterans and their spouses
- 10 who meet admission requirements contained in RCW 72.36.030.
- 11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** This act takes effect upon certification by
- 12 the director of the office of financial management that sufficient and
- 13 specific funding, referencing this act by bill or chapter number, has
- 14 been provided by June 30, 2012, in the omnibus capital appropriations
- 15 act for the state funds required by the United States department of
- 16 veterans affairs state home construction grant program for the
- 17 construction of the state soldiers' home created in section 1 of this
- 18 act. A notice of certification must be filed with the code reviser for

- 1 publication in the state register. If a certificate is not filed by
- 2 the director of the office of financial management by June 30, 2012,
- 3 this act is null and void.
