1 AN ACT Relating to allowing department of fish and wildlife 2 enforcement officers to transfer service credit; and amending RCW 3 41.26.435.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 Sec. 1. RCW 41.26.435 and 2009 c 157 s 1 are each amended to read 6 as follows:

7 (1) A member of plan 2 who was a member of the public employees' retirement system plan 2 or plan 3 while employed as an enforcement 8 9 officer for the department of fish and wildlife has the option to make an election no later than December 31, 2009, filed in writing with the 10 department of retirement systems, to transfer all service credit 11 previously earned as an enforcement officer in the public employees' 12 13 retirement system plan 2 or plan 3 to the law enforcement officers' and 14 firefighters' retirement system plan 2. Service credit that a member 15 elects to transfer from the public employees' retirement system to the 16 law enforcement officers' and firefighters' retirement system under this section shall be transferred no earlier than June 30, ((2014))17 18 2012, and only after the member completes payment as provided in 19 subsection (2) of this section.

1 (2)(a) A member who elects to transfer service credit under 2 subsection (1) of this section shall make the payments required by this 3 subsection prior to having service credit earned as an enforcement 4 officer with the department of fish and wildlife under the public 5 employees' retirement system plan 2 or plan 3 transferred to the law 6 enforcement officers' and firefighters' retirement system plan 2.

(b) A member who elects to transfer service credit from the public 7 employees' retirement system plan 2 under this subsection shall pay, 8 9 for the applicable period of service, the difference between the contributions the employee paid to the public employees' retirement 10 11 system plan 2 and the contributions that would have been paid by the 12 employee had the employee been a member of the law enforcement 13 officers' and firefighters' retirement system plan 2, plus interest on this difference as determined by the director. This payment must be 14 made no later than June 30, 2014, and must be made prior to retirement. 15

(c) A member who elects to transfer service credit from the public 16 employees' retirement system plan 3 under this subsection shall 17 transfer to the law enforcement officers' and firefighters' retirement 18 system plan 2, for the applicable period of service, the full balance 19 20 of the member's defined contribution account within plan 3 as of the 21 effective date of the transfer. At no time will the member pay, for the applicable period of service, a sum less than the contributions 22 23 that would have been paid by the employee had the employee been a 24 member of the law enforcement officers' and firefighters' retirement system plan 2, plus interest as determined by the director. 25 This 26 transfer and any additional payment, if necessary, must be made no 27 later than June 30, 2014, and must be made prior to retirement.

28 (d) Upon completion of the payment required in (b) of this 29 subsection, the department shall transfer from the public employees' retirement system to the law enforcement officers' and firefighters' 30 retirement system plan 2: (i) All of the employee's applicable 31 accumulated contributions plus interest and all of the applicable 32 33 employer contributions plus interest; and (ii) all applicable months of service, as defined in RCW 41.26.030(((14))) (28)(b), credited to the 34 35 employee under this chapter for service as an enforcement officer with 36 the department of fish and wildlife as though that service was rendered 37 as a member of the law enforcement officers' and firefighters' 38 retirement system plan 2.

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(e) Upon completion of the payment required in (c) of this 1 2 subsection, the department shall transfer from the public employees' retirement system to the law enforcement officers' and firefighters' 3 4 retirement system plan 2: (i) All of the employee's applicable accumulated contributions plus interest and all of the applicable 5 employer contributions plus interest; and (ii) all applicable months of 6 service, as defined in RCW 41.26.030(((14))) (28)(b), credited to the 7 8 employee under this chapter for service as an enforcement officer with the department of fish and wildlife as though that service was rendered 9 10 as a member of the law enforcement officers' and firefighters' 11 retirement system plan 2.

(f) If a member who elected to transfer pursuant to this section dies or retires for disability prior to June 30, ((2014)) 2012, the member's benefit is calculated as follows:

(i) All of the applicable service credit, accumulated contributions, and interest is transferred to the law enforcement officers' and firefighters' retirement system plan 2 and used in the calculation of a benefit.

(ii) If a member's obligation under (b) or (c) of this subsection has not been paid in full at the time of death or disability retirement, the member, or in the case of death the surviving spouse or eligible minor children, have the following options:

23 (A) Pay the bill in full;

(B) If a continuing monthly benefit is chosen, have the benefit
actuarially reduced to reflect the amount of the unpaid obligation
under (b) or (c) of this subsection; or

(C) Continue to make payment against the obligation under (b) or
(c) of this subsection, provided that payment in full is made no later
than June 30, 2014.

30 (g) Upon transfer of service credit, contributions, and interest 31 under this subsection, the employee is permanently excluded from 32 membership in the public employees' retirement system for all service 33 related to time served as an enforcement officer with the department of 34 fish and wildlife under the public employees' retirement system plan 2 35 or plan 3.

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
