

VETO MESSAGE ON E2SHB 1599

May 10, 2011

To the Honorable Speaker and Members,
The House of Representatives of the State of Washington

Ladies and Gentlemen:

I am returning herewith, without my approval as to Section 1,
Engrossed Second Substitute House Bill 1599 entitled:

"AN ACT Relating to establishing the pay for actual
student success dropout prevention program."

To the extent funding is provided in the appropriations act by
June 30, 2011, this legislation provides resources to schools
and school districts that improve various student engagement
and success factors that lead to more high school graduations.
The legislation sets forth the data used to determine whether
schools and districts are eligible for the incentives
authorized.

Section 1 is an intent section that discusses various
experiences of schools and principles of law, and is not
necessary to interpret or implement the substantive provisions
of the bill. For this reason, I have vetoed Section 1 of
Engrossed Second Substitute House Bill 1599.

With the exception of Section 1, Engrossed Second Substitute
House Bill 1599 is approved.
