Establishes the office of the chief information officer and partners it with the director of the office of financial management and the director of the department of personnel to provide state government with the cohesive structure necessary to develop improved operating models with agency directors and to reengineer business process to enhance service delivery while capturing savings.

Eliminates the information services board.

Creates the information technology advisory board, the consolidated technology services agency, and the consolidated technology services board.
