(DIGEST AS ENACTED)

Requires the department of social and health services to continue to operate the state-funded foster care to twenty-one program for three years after the effective date of the act, at which point the program shall cease to operate.

Allows youth participating in the foster care to twentyone program to continue to receive placement services until the youth reaches his or her twenty-first birthday or is no longer enrolled in and participating in a postsecondary program, whichever is earlier.
