- 4 Sec. 1. RCW 26.04.050 and 2012 c 3 s 4 are each amended to read as follows:
- The following named officers and persons, active or retired, are hereby authorized to solemnize marriages, to wit: Justices of the
- 8 supreme court, judges of the court of appeals, judges of the superior
- 9 courts, supreme court commissioners, court of appeals commissioners,
- superior court commissioners, <u>judges of courts of limited jurisdiction</u>
  as defined in RCW 3.02.010, judges of tribal courts, administrative law
- 12 <u>judges appointed under RCW 34.12.030, and</u> any regularly licensed or
- ordained minister or any priest, imam, rabbi, or similar official of
- 14 any religious organization((,-and-judges-of-courts-of-limited
- 15 jurisdiction—as—defined—in—RCW—3.02.010)). That a marriage is
- 16 <u>solemnized by a tribal court judge pursuant to authority under this</u>
- 17 <u>section does not create tribal court jurisdiction and does not affect</u>
- 18 state court authority as otherwise provided by law to enter a judgment
