1 AN ACT Relating to recommendations for streamlining reporting 2 requirements for taxes and fees on spirits; adding a new section to 3 chapter 66.08 RCW; and creating a new section.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. The legislature finds that the adoption of 6 Initiative Measure No. 1183 by the voters in 2011 privatized the sale 7 and distribution of spirits in Washington. The legislature also finds 8 that reporting requirements for all liquor taxes and fees are 9 administratively complex and require payment and reporting to multiple 10 state agencies.

11 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 66.08 RCW 12 to read as follows:

By September 30, 2013, and in compliance with RCW 43.01.036, the board and the department of revenue must make recommendations to the legislature that detail the statutory changes necessary to: Streamline the collection of liquor taxes, fees, and reports; and require a

- 2 revenue and information.
