AN ACT Relating to exemptions from prevailing wage for school plant facilities receiving state funding assistance through the school construction assistance program; and amending RCW 39.12.020.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 39.12.020 and 2007 c 169 s 1 are each amended to read 6 as follows:

7 (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, the hourly wages to be paid to laborers, workers, or mechanics, upon all 8 9 public works and under all public building service maintenance 10 contracts of the state or any county, municipality or political subdivision created by its laws, shall be not less than the prevailing 11 rate of wage for an hour's work in the same trade or occupation in the 12 13 locality within the state where such labor is performed. For a 14 contract in excess of ten thousand dollars, a contractor required to 15 pay the prevailing rate of wage shall post in a location readily 16 visible to workers at the job site: PROVIDED, That on road construction, sewer line, pipeline, transmission line, street, or alley 17 18 improvement projects for which no field office is needed or 19 established, a contractor may post the prevailing rate of wage

statement at the contractor's local office, gravel crushing, concrete, or asphalt batch plant as long as the contractor provides a copy of the wage statement to any employee on request:

4 (((1))) (a) A copy of a statement of intent to pay prevailing wages
5 approved by the industrial statistician of the department of labor and
6 industries under RCW 39.12.040; and

7 (((2))) (b) The address and telephone number of the industrial
8 statistician of the department of labor and industries where a
9 complaint or inquiry concerning prevailing wages may be made.

(2) This chapter shall not apply to:

11 (a) Workers or other persons regularly employed by the state, or 12 any county, municipality, or political subdivision created by its laws<u>:</u> 13 or

(b) School plant facility projects receiving state funding
 assistance through the school construction assistance program provided
 for in RCW 28A.525.162 through 28A.525.180.
